About CancerCare Manitoba

CancerCare Manitoba (CCMB) is the provincially mandated cancer agency in Manitoba, responsible for delivery of cancer services across the province. CCMB provides care, treatment, and support services across the entire cancer continuum, from prevention, early diagnosis, treatment and care, to end of life care. CCMB has more than 800 staff, including world class experts in medical and radiation oncology, top researchers, nursing staff including those with an expanded role as nurse practitioners, and many other health care professionals.
