ARIA: GAST - [de Gramont (MET)]

Planned Course:Every 14 days until disease progression or unacceptable toxicityIndication for Use:Colorectal Cancer Metastatic

CVAD: Required (Ambulatory Pump)

# Proceed with treatment if:

ANC equal to or greater than  $1.5 \times 10^9/L$  AND Platelets equal to or greater than  $100 \times 10^9/L$ 

Contact Physician if parameters not met

# **Treatment Regimen – GAST – de Gramont**

Drug	Dose	CCMB Administration Guideline
dexamethasone	8 mg	Orally 30 minutes pre-chemotherapy
fluorouracil	2400 mg/m <sup>2</sup>	IV in D5W continuously over 46 hours by ambulatory infusion device

# **REQUIRED MONITORING**

All Cycles

• CBC, serum creatinine, urea, liver enzymes and total bilirubin as per Physician Orders

# **Recommended Support Medications**

Drug	Dose	CCMB Administration Guideline
metoclopramide	10 – 20 mg	Orally every 4 hours as needed for nausea and vomiting



#### **DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS**

- Instruct patient to continue taking anti-emetic(s) at home
- Ensure patient has received a home chemotherapy spill kit and instructions for use
- Reinforce applicable safe handling precautions of medications, blood and body fluids for 48 hours after completion of chemotherapy
