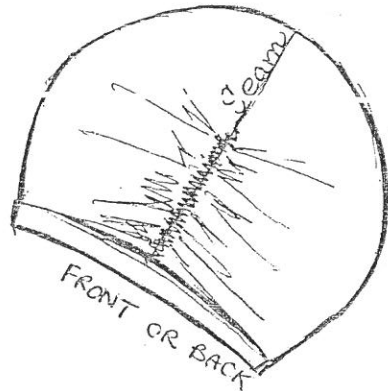


## Turban Instructions

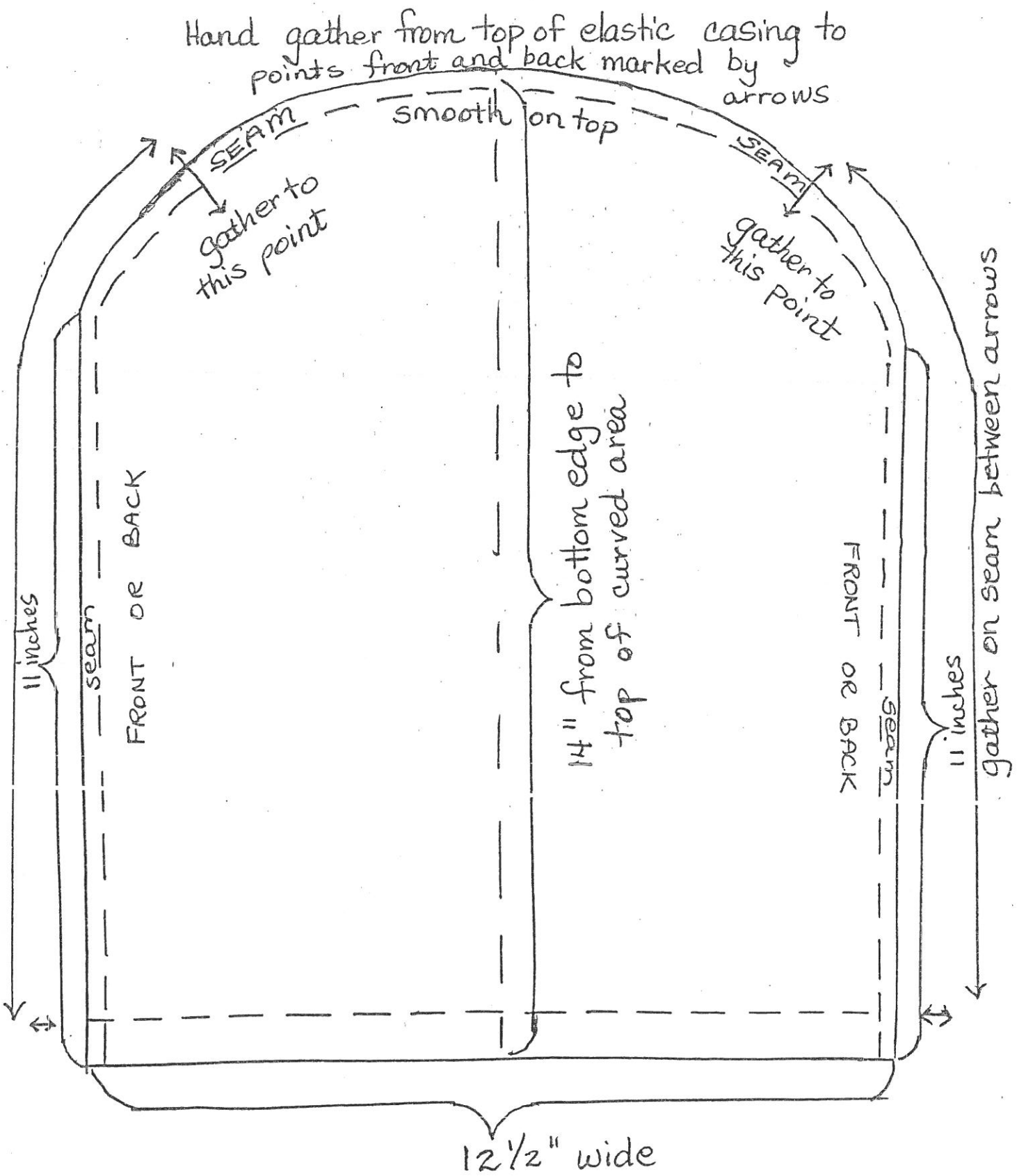
1. Using a brown paper grocery bag, enlarge the enclosed pattern according to the dimensions given on the sketch.
2. Using the pattern, cut 2 pieces of soft-knit fabric (cotton or poly-cotton)
3. Sew and then zigzag stitch (or serge) along the seam edge of the fabric. Leave straight edge open at bottom.
4. Serge or zigzag stitch bottom edge. Fold over  $1/4$ " and then  $3/4$ " and stitch all around to create an elastic casing, leaving enough open to insert elastic.
5. Use  $1/4$ " or  $3/8$ " wide elastic, 24" long to run through casing. Overlap ends of elastic 1" and sew securely together. Finish the hem closure, or join elastic first and slip over open end of turban. Fold hem over elastic and stitch. (This eliminates step 4.)
6. To gather front and back, take a very long thread and double it, thread a needle to create 4 threads total, Knot ends and make a running stitch to hand gather from the top of the elastic casing to the top side of the curve as indicated on the pattern. Gathered areas should measure about 4" from the top of the elastic casing to the stop point on the curve. Finished turban should resemble this sketch.
