The Residency Program at CancerCare Manitoba has two funded resident positions and as such takes in two, one or zero residents per year depending on the timing of intake (the training program is two years in duration).

Since 2008, three Residents have been appointed to permanent, clinical Medical Physicist positions at CancerCare Manitoba prior to completing their residency programs; these individuals completed or are completing their programs while permanently employed.

In 2016 there were no changes in the Residency Program. Two residents entered the Program in the fall of 2015 and will complete their Program in the fall of 2017.
