

Manitoba Home Cancer Drug Program

The Home Cancer Drug (HCD) Program is a Pharmacare program for Manitobans diagnosed with cancer. It covers the cost of oral medications used to treat cancer and manage nausea, ensuring patients receive these essential drugs at no cost.

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for this program, you must be registered with the Manitoba Pharmacare Program and meet the following criteria:

- Have Manitoba Health coverage.
- Have filed your taxes last year.
- Your prescriptions cannot be covered by other provincial or federal programs (e.g. Non Insured Health Benefits, Department of Veteran Affairs, Family Services).

Filling Your Prescriptions

- Wait 2-3 business days after registering before filling prescriptions.
- If your medication isn't covered at the pharmacy, call to confirm your registration before paying.
- Manitoba Pharmacare will not reimburse you for prescriptions you have already paid for.

Please advise your clinic team if issues with your registration are causing delays in starting your medication.
