The private records of CancerCare Manitoba's CervixCheck show that you are due for a Pap test.

Contact your doctor or nurse to make an appointment for a Pap test.

Why are regular Pap tests important?

Pap tests help prevent cervical cancer. Pap tests can find abnormal cell changes on the cervix. If we treat these changes early, we can prevent cervical cancer.

What is CervixCheck?

CervixCheck keeps private records of all Pap tests and follow-up results in Manitoba. We use this information so that we can:

- remind you to have your regular Pap test, and
- inform you of abnormal results when follow-up is needed.
