To Implement New Provincial Forms – Endoscopy Intake Referral Form & Fecal Occult Blood Test Requisition

Date effective: April 19, 2022

Background Information:

Shared Health and CancerCare Manitoba are releasing two new forms to support gastrointestinal healthcare in Manitoba:

- Shared Health Endoscopy Intake Referral Form
- ColonCheck Fecal Occult Blood Test Requisition

The forms will standardize requests for endoscopy and fecal occult blood testing ensuring equitable service delivery, improved prioritization and scheduling of endoscopic procedures in Manitoba. These forms align processes to the colorectal cancer screening and surveillance guideline https://www.cancercare.mb.ca/screening/hcp as well as Choosing Wisely principles.

Clinical Practice Change:

Beginning April 19, 2022, providers will be required to use the following new forms. Please delete all old forms from your systems. Please disseminate this Clinical Practice Change to all appropriate stakeholders in your areas by April 4, 2022.

<u>Endoscopy Intake Referral Form</u> - Use this provincially standardized form to request any outpatient gastrointestinal endoscopy referral within your region. This form is to be sent according to current practice, whether that is to a specific endoscopy provider, clinic, or central intake site.

<u>Fecal Occult Blood Test Requisition</u> - Use this form to order a fecal occult blood test from ColonCheck CancerCare Manitoba. This requisition can be used to request the following:

- Guaiac fecal occult blood test (gFOBT) for average risk colorectal cancer screening for patients age 50
 years and older
- Fecal immunochemical test (FIT) for low increased risk colorectal cancer screening in selected individuals, as an alternative to colonoscopy
- FIT for low risk adenoma surveillance, as an alternative to colonoscopy

- As of April 19, 2022, only the new Endoscopy Intake Referral Form is to be accepted.
