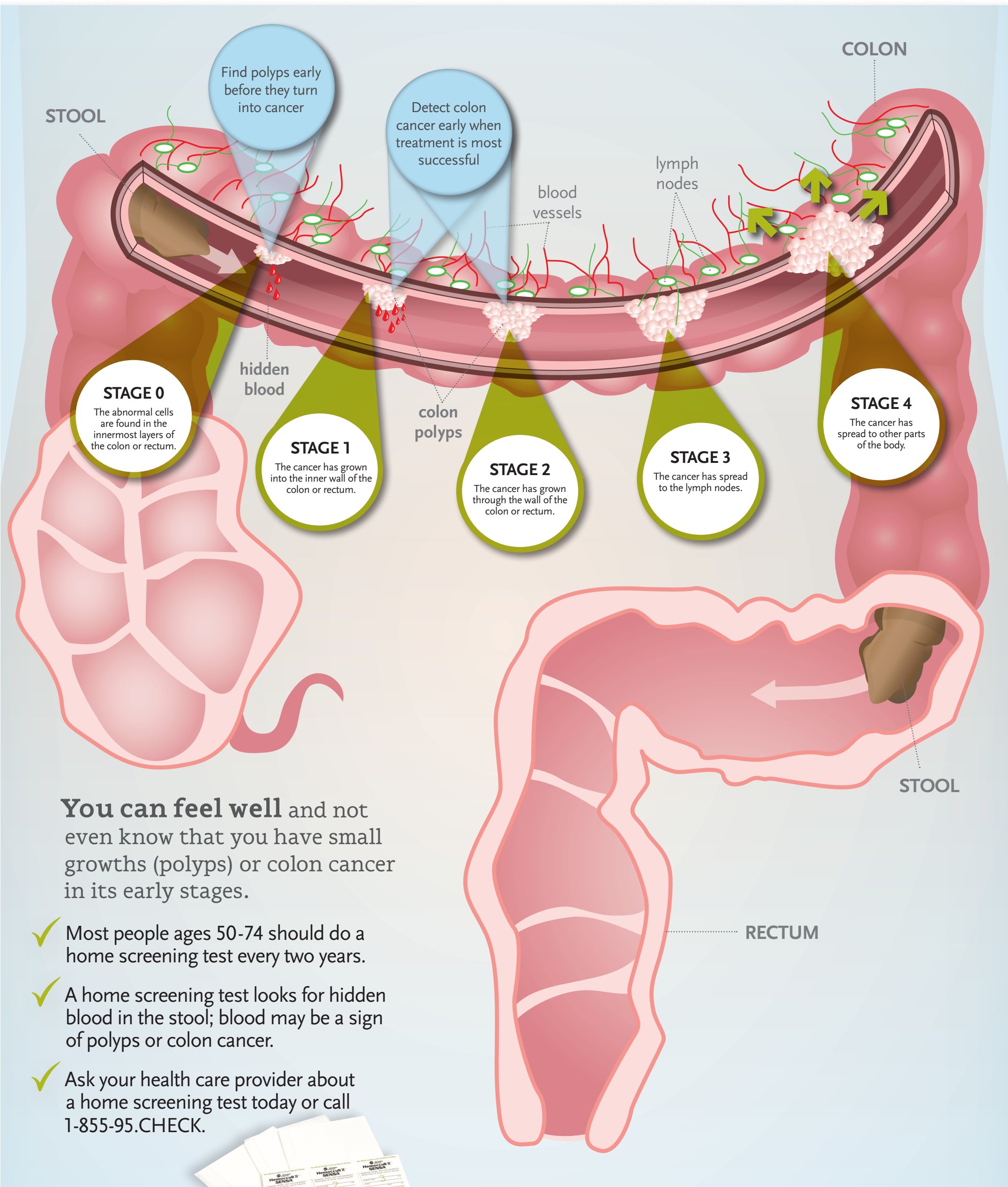


Colon Cancer Screening Saves Lives

You can feel well and not even know that you have small growths (polyps) or colon cancer in its early stages.

- ✓ Most people ages 50-74 should do a home screening test every two years.
- ✓ A home screening test looks for hidden blood in the stool; blood may be a sign of polyps or colon cancer.
